'No, the Lord expressly forbids that'


'And how old are you?'

'Ahh Mary. That is good for starting a debate about liberalism, inclusiveness, sharing, mutual and experiential reaching out.....


Mary had a little lamb

'Just a little longer'


'Good morning. You represent the Heads of Local Councils, but they are complaining you are failing to represent them properly' 'Not true'

'Yes, but only five are social. See, that's where the mistake is made'


'Ok, she told me about a game recently at a Course near the flooded Severn?'

'No, I don't! The shop is just my base. I am a golf pro!'


'Who manages a shop'

'So...?'


'So that's it, end of world'

'Irma....what are you saying?'


'Well, what about the people that executed me? They hanged me'


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- 'Good morning Vatsyanana, how are you?'

'When I'm good, I'm very good, but when I'm bad, I'm crap' 'better.....'


'I'll try anything once, twice if I like it, three times bores me' 'to make sure'

'I know. And of course, this was no secret, it was seen by many people, but they did nothing. Some of them laughed at our plight'



'Well now I have escaped, which is wonderful, but a part of me feels I should be back there, doing what I am supposed to do'



'Aww, I like Princess Anne'


'Andrew wasn't involved as he had brought two fourteen-year-old girls and they were in one of the cottages, so he went there while the others paired off'

'And didn't they appeal to teenagers?'


'Yes. Why?'

'What are you going to do for the North?'



'Yes?'


'I can now sing falsetto'


'And the other ...?'

'But what if I do report it? Does it exist then?'


'Not if we don't record it.....'

'How so?'


'For a crime to have happened it has to be recorded, otherwise it has only been reported, which has no value'

'It's a ...'


'Ok, our beloved Nelson and South Africa may not be a good example so how about....?'

'How about......'


'Yes?'

'Michael Jackson.....?'






'So, you are concerned that your attitude towards the suffering and the poor is changing?' 'It's not just that'

'What are you going to do?'


'I don't know. I mean I used to be good, more than good, omnipotent really, but now look at me. I'm a disaster.'

'Very good'


'And then I took it farther to try and understand the economic issues. Some of the rescuers had to leave work to rescue me and that would have cost them money, plus any expense getting to me'
